NB A novice horse is one that has not been placed 1st 3 times (prior to the start of the current season) and /or has never qualified for HOYS. Horses competing in the UK for their first season under saddle are only deemed a novice if they have not been riden in open classes abroad.

Note 4 — Ridden Pure Bred Arabs

Classes 21, 22 & 23 - This Show is a qualifier for the Ridden Pure Bred Arabs - Stallion, Mare & Gelding sections at the Horse Of The Year Show to be held at N.E.C. Birmingham. Note 8 — Crabbet - Classes 32 & 33

1st and 2nd winners in each class qualify for the National Crabbet In-Hand Championship to be held at AHS. Malvern2009

A copy of the Heritage Certificate issued by the Crabbet Organisation or a letter from the the Secretary confirming that the entered horse has 75%+ Crabbet blood will be required or the entry will be refused. All horses forward must be shown naturally - in the more traditional manner. Any unnatural posing, flicking of the whip or circling when being run out, will result in the horse being judged as though no presentation or display had been possible and therefore penalized accordingly.

ALL NUMBERS TO BE COLLECTED AT THE SHOW

Wales & West Arab Horse Show — REGULATIONS

- R1 All animals must be registered with the Arab Horse Society.
- R2 All animals to be on the Show Ground 30 minutes before the class.
- R3 The decision of the Judge is final.
- R4 Upon recommendations of the Judges, the Organisers reserve the right to withhold prizes if entries are not of sufficient merit
- R5 This show will be conducted in accordance with the show rules and regulations of The Arab Horse Society, and E.C.A.H.O. Rules.
- R6 Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage, done to, occasioned by, or arising from any animal exhibited by him, and for the description given in the Catalogue and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Committee against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto and repay any injury which may be so occasioned.
- R7 The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or further divide classes if entries so warrant.
- R8 All entries must be accompanied by the proper fees, & a copy of registration certificate, according to the schedule.

- R9 1st & 2nd prize winners of each class must take part in the appropriate championship unless a veterinary certificate is produced. Failure to compete will disqualify the horse from the show, with its record of score and class placing being deleted and the horse being disqualified from showing for the period of one year as from the date of the show. In the event of disqualification, horses placed below the disqualified horse will move up a place in the class but not be entitled to enter the championship.
- d2) When the champion has been selected the reserve will be selected in the same way from the other first placed horses, together with the horse placed second to the champion.
- R10 All animals must be the bona fida property of the Exhibitor at the time of entry.
- R11 No substitution of entries will be permitted after the closing date of the entries.
- R12 All Challenge cups to be returned to the secretary by the 9th April, 2009.
- R13 No Mare or her Foal to be shown in any class unless the Foal is at least three weeks old.
- R14 No refund of fee under any circumstances.

Note:- New Rules For Stabling

- 1 All stables will be allocated to exhibitors
- Anyone found occupying a stable which is not theirs, or is not paid for will be excluded from the Show with no refund **This rule will be enforced**.
- 3 The Stable Manager will be on the Showground from 4pm until 10.00pm on Friday 15th May. No entry after this time Gates will be closed and will reopen at 6.00am Saturday 16th May.
- 4 No straw to be brought to the Showground. Anyone breaking this rule will be excluded from the Show with no refund.
- All stables must be mucked out before leaving the Showground to the satisfaction of the showground owners. Penalty for not doing so will be a fine of £25 per stable or exclusion from the 2010 Show.
